PREVENT DUTY AND BRITISH VALUES

All staff and committee who are part of St John's Sunshine pre-school have a legal obligation to follow 'Prevent duty.' This sets out the need for 'British Values' to help ensure that everyone is kept safe and free from harm, it also ensures that everyone is welcome into the local community.

At St John's Sunshine Pre School, we will ensure that everyone is made to feel welcome within the pre-school. We will ensure this occurs by doing the following defined British Values.

- Democracy
- The rule of law
- Individual liberty and mutual respect
- Tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs. These values are universal aspirations equality
- Supporting the children within our care to become more compassionate and considerate therefore giving the direction for the future, making them adults who form of fair and equal society

The staff at St John's Sunshine Pre school will also ensure they observe the following:

- Staff will be alert to harmful behaviours by influential adults in a child's life. This may include discrimination and/or extremist discussions between parents, family and/or staff members
- St John's Sunshine Pre school safeguarding policy and procedure will be put into action if any behaviour or concern is witnessed
- Staff will identify children who may be vulnerable to radicalisations and know what to do when they are identified. They assess the risk of the children being drawn into terrorism and work in partnership with local partners such a the police, prevent coordination, CAP, Ofsted and their local safeguarding children Board.
- Staff will attend prevent training to ensure they understand their responsibilities
